He is the subject expert and referee for Ph.D for more than 25 students and for D.Lit of various universities in Maharashtra like Nagpur, Amravati, Aurangabad, Kolhapur, Nanded along with University of Pune. He also worked on the Selection Committee in Nanded University. Dr. V.S. More is recognized on the Research Guide of University of Pune in the faculty of Commerce and Management and has guided 14 Ph.D. students and 6 are pursuing Ph.D. under his guidance. He is recognized guide for M.Phil in Y.C.M.O.U. Nashik and 3 students have completed M.Phil under him. He has worked as the Peer Team Member of NAAC Committee.

A BRIEF REPORT

Revision Of B.Com Course: The University Grants Commission New Delhi circulated UGC Model curriculum for Commerce Course in December 2001, requesting university to update the curriculum as per the guideline held. In April 2002 the information regarding the problems which could arise in adopting 100% model curriculum was submitted to Hon'ble V.C. Faculty meeting was on 26th Nov.2002 to discuss the various issues in framing the new syllabus on the basis of model curriculum of UGC. Ex-Deans were invited to attend the meeting and express their views on the issue. The Faculty and Ex Deans suggested to invite Dr. Arun Nigavekar UGC chairman for his guidance on this issue. Accordingly Dr. Arun Nigavekar was invited and he gave his consent to attend the meeting on 13th Dec. 2002 at 3.30 pm in Pune University with V.C. Dean, Ex Deans and Chairmen of BOS. The meeting was attended by Dr. Nigavekar, Dr. Kolaskar, Dr.V.S. More, Dr. Shewalkar, Dr. Kolte, Dr. Raosaheb Shinde and nine Ex-Deans. He expressed his views and suggested not to accept 100% model curriculum but to modify the present structure as per the local needs. Discussion with honorable Chancellor and Governor of Maharashtra His Excellency Shri Moh'd Fasal was held on 14th Aug.2003.All Deans and Management Council members were present. Hon'ble Chancellor also inaugurated new Administrative Building, examination automation facility and RFID technology at Jaykar Library. All BOS were informed to prepare the revised structure and syllabus. Faculty discussed the structure and syllabus prepared by all Twelve BOS. The faculty unanimously decided to call the opinions of teachers by organizing workshops at district level. The workshops were organized in Pune (BMCC College), Ahmednagar Institute of Management (CSR D), Nashik at M.S.G. College, Malegaon. Mostly all teachers were involved in these workshops and submitted fruitful suggestions. On this basis the BOS Chairman Meeting was held on 29th Oct. and faculty meeting on 30th Oct. 2003. The final structure and syllabus was accepted and forwarded to Academic Council, and latter on it was accepted by Academic Council. The proposed structure and syllabus was supposed to be implemented by June 2004 for F.Y. B.Com, June 2005 S.Y.B.Com and June 2006 T.Y.B.Com. vide circular No.266 / 2004 was issued on 18/06/2004.

Revision Of M.Com Course: The structure and syllabus of M.Com was under consideration of the faculty. As per the Model curriculum of UGC and approved it in May 2002 and forwarded to the Academic council for its approval. After approval from Academic Council, M.Com new structure and syllabus was introduced from Academic year 2002-2003 for part I and 2003-2004 for M.Com Part II. In M.Com part II for paper IV 'Research Methodology and Project', the division of marks was 30 for Project writing, 20 marks for Project Viva-Voce and 50 marks for Theory examination. For external M.Com students, Case Study was introduced with necessary guidelines.

Equivalence: Equivalence for various subjects were approved by the Faculty in May 2002 for Old course with the revised course.

Introduction of Certificates & Diploma Courses: Certificate and diploma courses were introduced in Banking and Finance, Marketing, Insurance and Transport, Co-operation and Rural Developments.

- Term End examination for B.Com and M.Com was continued as it is. Career oriented courses scheme was implemented from 2003-2004 as per UGC guidelines.
- Certificate course in E-Commerce was introduced.
- In Commerce Faculty Guidelines for Commerce Lab and the fees for practical was finalized.
- In April 2004, a resolution was unanimously passed for establishments of Department of Commerce at the University campus and accordingly the provision was made in the budget.
- Foundation course in commerce was introduced in feb.2004.

As the Dean Faculty of Commerce, Chairman Of BOS, Header Of The Senate, Academic Council, Board of Examinations and member on various committees.

The following resolutions were panel and implemented effectively during my tenure.

- Norms for Admission in Commerce faculty in affiliated colleges.
- Norms for workload of teachers in the faculty were framed and a report was submitted to the Director Of Education for the approval
- Fee structure was revised due to Drought situation in Pune University area.
- LIC were appointed for the affiliated colleges and institutions.
- Budgets for Examination Department were prepared
- Rules and Regulations for the continuation of affiliation of colleges and institutions were revised.
- Action Plans of the University under the EDUSAT Program was prepared.
- Rules & Regulation For the award of M.Phil, Ph.D., D.Lit / D.Sc. were revised.
- Environmental Awareness subject was introduced at S. Y. B.com. level.
- New norms for Quality Improvement Program was also laid down.
- CAPS were conducted at various colleges.

Under the able Chairmanship of Dr. S.B. Kolte, the faculty of Commerce and Management felicitated Dr.P.C. Shejawalkar on the occasion of his Platinum Jubilee on 17th Jan 2003. The program was graced by Dr. Uttamrao Bhoite, former V.C.,Bharti Vidyapith, Dr. Ashok Kolaskar V.C. Dr. Shridhar Gupte former V.C. Dr. Rode Nagpur University, Dr. S.B. Kolte, Dr. V.S. More, Dr. Raosaheb Shinde and others. The Committee also raised fund of Rs. 1,00,000/- and handed over to Dr. Kolaskar for Gold Medal in the name of Dr. P.C. Shejwalkar for topper at M.Com and MBA final exam.

During my tenure as the Dean, I was very keen to prepare updated list of paper-setters, moderators and examiners (including practical exams) for the smooth conduct of assessment and declaration of results on time. All chairmen of BOS, faculty members and members of BOS, all officers and University authorities whole heartedly co- operated me during my tenure as the Dean.

I put on record my sincere thanks to all who extended their cooperation and guidance during my tenure as the Dean.
